

INDECOM investigating death of Leon Griffiths

December 2, 2010 - The Independent Commission of Investigations (INDECOM) has commenced formal investigations into the circumstances surrounding the death of Leon Griffiths.

Griffith, who was 24 year old was shot and killed at his home in Gordon Crescent, Granville, St. James at approximately 7:30 a.m. on Tuesday, November 30, 2010.

INDECOM investigators have recorded statements from witnesses, and the necessary forensic information is being gathered.

About INDECOM

INDECOM, which began operations on August 16, 2010, was established to investigate actions by members of the Security Forces and other agents of the State that result in death or injury or the abuse of rights. The body currently has 12 investigators. The recruitment and training exercise for the staff of INDECOM is ongoing.
